Barney was born in London and was raised in tropical Far North Queensland, Australia. Being raised off grid instilled at an early age a heightened respect for the value of energy, basic necessity, and everyday convenience. Barney's passion for the planet motivates him daily to build a legacy through tangible solutions that are attainable by all.
