She has also held the roles of Stewardship Director and Associate Director at ARC. During her 17-year tenure at ARC, Elena has managed several successful habitat restoration and land acquisition projects and has built relationships with local and regional funding agencies, partners and stakeholders. She has also served as the Lead Instructor for the California Naturalist Certification Course at ARC. Ms. DeLacy is a passionate advocate for land conservation in the greater Sacramento region and the Sierra Nevada, the source of 60% of California’s water. Born and raised in Sacramento, Elena received her Bachelor of Science in Environmental Biology and Management from UC Davis.</p>
